Under Section 92 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 the Secretary of State may refuse to issue a driving licence on the grounds of the applicant's medical fitness. Those who are currently banned from holding a licence are people with:-

- Epilepsy (unless it is of a type which does not pose a danger).

- Severe mental disorder.

- Liability to sudden attacks of giddiness or fainting (whether as a result of cardiac disorder of otherwise).

- Inability to read a registration plate in good light at 20.5 metres (with lenses if worn).

- Other disabilities which are likely to cause the driving of vehicles be them to be a source of danger to the public.

Revocation of licence due to misuse of drugs and/or alcohol – Applicants are not covered by the definition of 'disabled person' under the Act and are thus not entitled to the statutory minimum travel.
